In order to allow refugee students to attain a university degree, Kiron will break down the four barriers identified by UNHCR in their Education Strategy 2012-2016.




Through its holistic approach to learning, Kiron opens the door for refugee students to access university.







Kiron's threefold Business Model will ensure sustainable revenue inflows in the long-run




Raising Human Capital Threefold

Our threefold business model algns with our students' successes throughout their academic and professional journey:


- I. HR Talent Pool: Corporate partners pay lump sums in order to secure a targeted sponsorship and mentoring.
- **II. University Revenue Sharing**: When Kiron students transfer to partner universities, governmental funding provided to transfer university is split between Kiron and the latter
- III. Reverse Generational Contract: Kiron graduates redirect portions of future gross salaries to finance succeeding cohorts


