





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2018 **Open Source** Jobs Report

- Hiring open source talent is a priority for 83% of hiring managers (from 76% in 2017)
- > 87% of hiring managers are having a hard time recruiting enough open source talent

Training the Next Generation of Open Source Developers



Provide affordable, vendor-neutral educational opportunities that build foundational knowledge, skills & competence in open source software:

- ➤ Instructor-led classes
- Self-paced, online courses
- Professional certification exams

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STRATEGY focused on 3 components

- **G** Free introductory MOOCs
- More advanced, hands-on training (eLearning and instructor-led)
 - **D** Professional certification exams



eLearning Courses

- At least 50% of time spent on hands-on labs
- Lectures are a combination of text, graphics, and videos
- Mostly demo videos, to enhance the learning experience (usually less than 30% of total training time)
- Quizzes

The Linux Foundation eLearning Journey: The First Steps



Introduction to Linux (LFS101x)

- Launched August 1st, 2014
- Multiple reruns
- Over 800k enrollments
- Teaches immediately applicable entry-level Linux skills

Collaborative Learning Trends in LFS101x

Connect learners and allow them to take an active role

DISCUSSIONS

- Informal
- Unstructured
- Moderator more peripheral role

Learners provide support to peer learners

Local and virtual study groups, engaging peer learners

Threads in different languages (Russian, Spanish, etc.)



Blockchain for Business: An Introduction to Hyperledger Technologies (LFS171x)



- Targets a blend of business-oriented and technical learners
- Collaboration patterns in the forum similar to those in the *Intro to Linux* MOOC
 - Learner support
 - Study groups
 - Collaboration on startup blockchain projects



Open Sourcing the Course Creation Process

The Hyperledger Learning Materials Development Working Group:

- Current and former students of the LFS171x MOOC, as well as Hyperledger community members
- Maintain and update course content
- Provide forum support
- Develop training materials to support all Hyperledger projects
